


Juicy burgers and charcoal grilled steaks are quintessential American foods. Beef is part of our country's heritage.

## 619,172 FARMS AND RANCHES SPECIALIZE IN BEEF CATTLE

83% of cattle ranches have remained in a family for more than a quarter of a century, 10% for more than 100 years.

AVERAGE COW HERD SIZE:

U.S. farmers and ranchers raise 20% of the world's beef supply with just 7% of the world cattle.
